# **NuSocia's Approach to Primary Research**



- NuSocia places significant emphasis on primary research. As it helps to gain deeper insights into community needs and development challenges
- Primary Research helps to gain deeper insights into community (including beneficiary & stakeholder) needs and development challenges



- Primary research is crucial for a better understanding of these issues along with accurately assessing the context, ground realities, needs, relevance, and feasibility as well as the outcome, output, and impact of various social development interventions
- Focus is on collecting firsthand information (quant & qual) through interaction with diverse, inclusive stakeholders across different levels and with relevant stakeholders to collect the appropriate data.

### **Approaches**

#### **Operational Planning**

- Area Mapping-village profiling, village listing etc
- Field Plan: day-wise details of primary research
- Scheduling data collection



#### **Stakeholder Engagement**

 Support from Gram Panchayat, Anganwadi, Schools and SHG for Mobilization



# Data Collection Methods

- Key Informant Interviews
- Focus Group Discussion
- Surveys,
- Participatory methods, PLA, observation



### **Research Ethics Protocol**



Researchers are mediators between the respondents and the concerned stakeholders



Researchers have great responsibility especially when dealing with human beings, their life aspects & such personal sensitive information



Researchers are responsible for the safety of respondents



Researchers are wary of labeling and attributing unworthy traits



Researchers observe good practices



Researchers have the responsibility of ensuring Data Privacy and Protection
